The **policy** of this University is that all procurement should be undertaken within the rules set out in the **Financial Regulations** manual and the procurement legislation of the **European Union**.

It is the intention of the procurement department:

- To communicate effectively with internal stakeholders
- To continue supporting the development of good practice.
- To promote the training and development of all staff involved in purchasing goods and services on behalf of the University

Commercial ethics

The University has a policy on commercial ethics. In all dealings with commercial partners, the interests of the University are paramount, and that personal or family gain, or the perception thereof, should be avoided. No inducements should be offered to, or requested by, members of staff, and all contracted companies should ensure that
